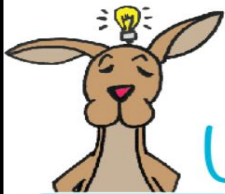
NGP Definition:

Explain how you can apply a lesson you have learnt from the story into your own life.

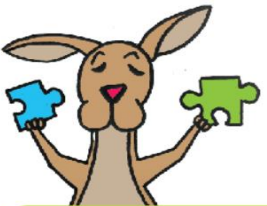
