week.

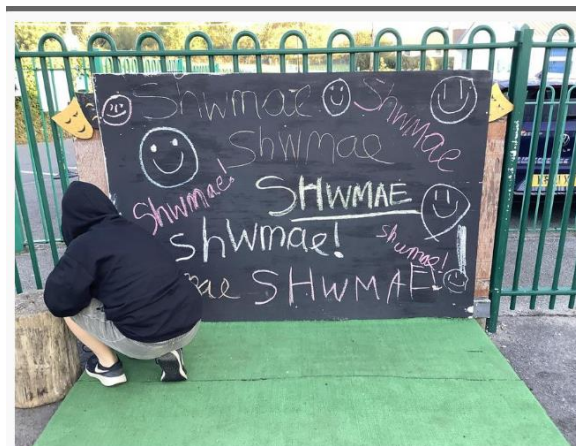
Dydd Mercher Maeth
