

Dydd Llun: Chaos




Pupils to work in pairs. One pupil lists the verbs in any order they wish, their partner then has to repeat the verbs in the same sequence.



Dydd Mawrth: Pasio'r Bom

Set a 30 second timer on the IWB. Give the children a range of different topic pictures to use in a sentence of their choice using the language pattern that you have been teaching e.g. Bwytas i... If the 'bomb' goes off whilst they are in the middle of translating their sentence then the child loses a life (they have 3 lives in total). Continue for a set time or until there is an overall winner.



Dydd Mercher: Oral Ping Pong

- The students work in pairs.
- They have a sheet with the same English sentences to translate into Welsh, but Partner A has the translation of half the sentences (e.g. sentences 1 to 10), whereas Partner B has the translation of the other half (e.g. sentences 11 to 20).
- The 2 partners take turns in challenging each other with a sentence.
- After one partner has attempted the translation, his/her opponent shows him/her the correct answer and points are awarded (3 for perfect sentence, 2 for one mistake only, 1 if there are numerous mistakes).
- Limit game to 10 mins and when the time is up the person with the higher score wins.
