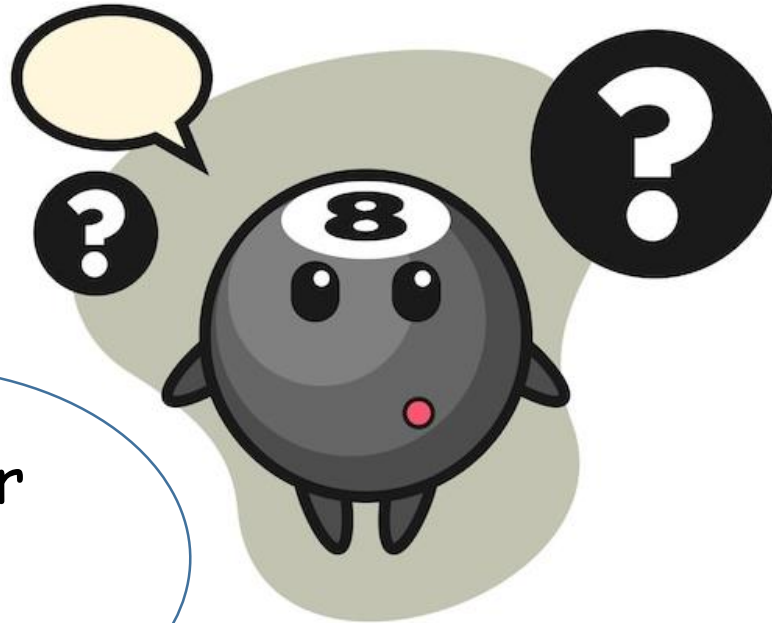
# Amser Adolygu: Question Ball

The teacher chooses three words. The children need to guess which words the teacher is thinking of.
