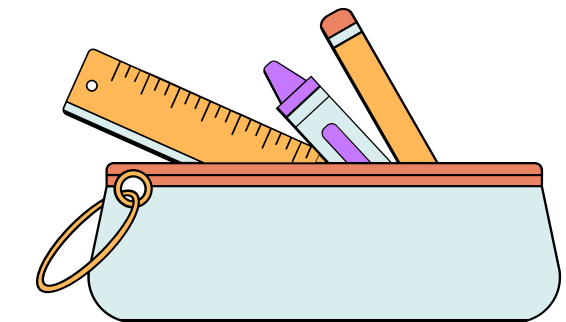
Expectations in Pry Cop

- rubber



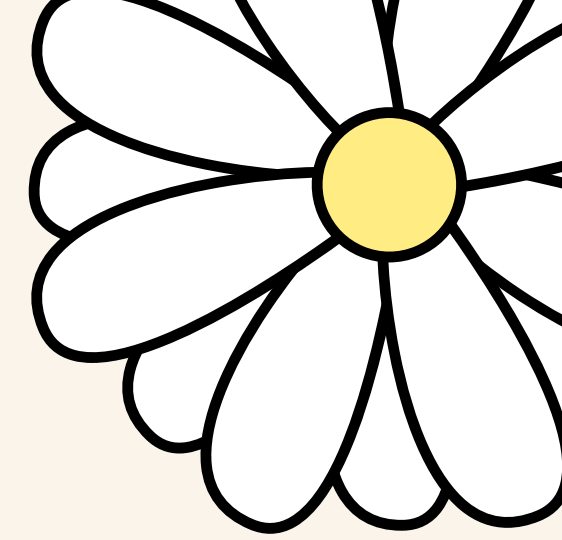
Water bottles – pupils need to bring a water bottle to school filled with water only please

Caffi is open every Thursday. All pupils will take part through a rota system. This rota has been emailed to parents this term.

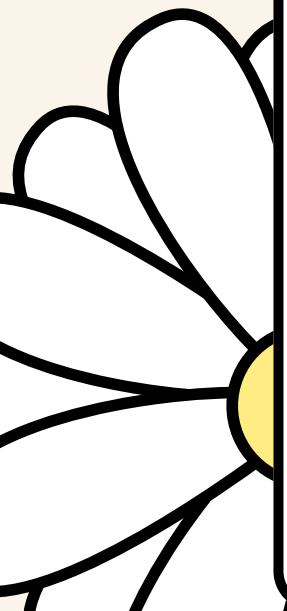
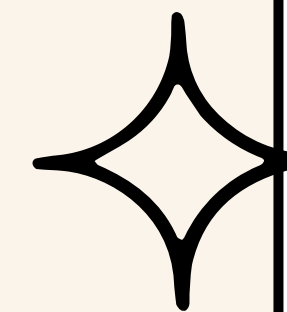
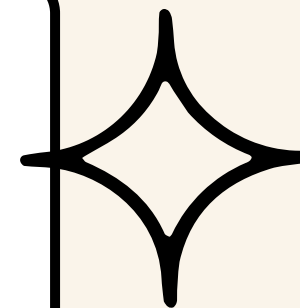
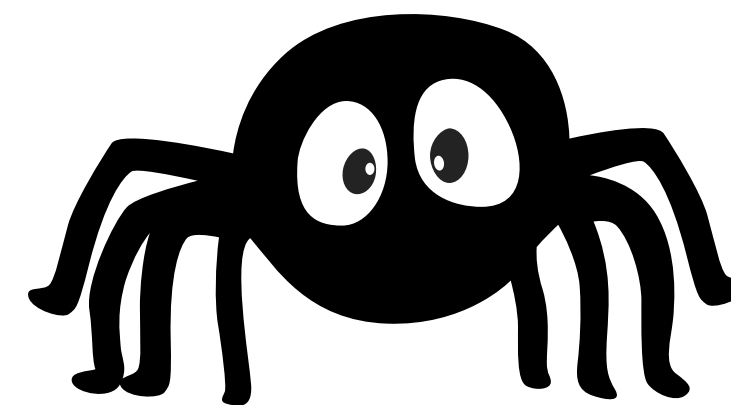

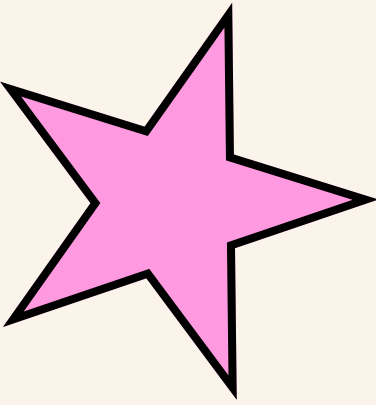
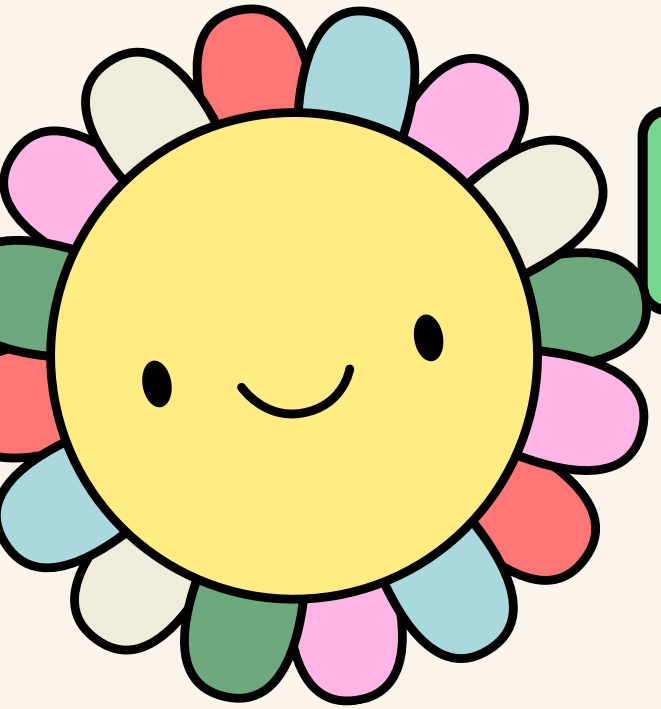
A space for all learning styles

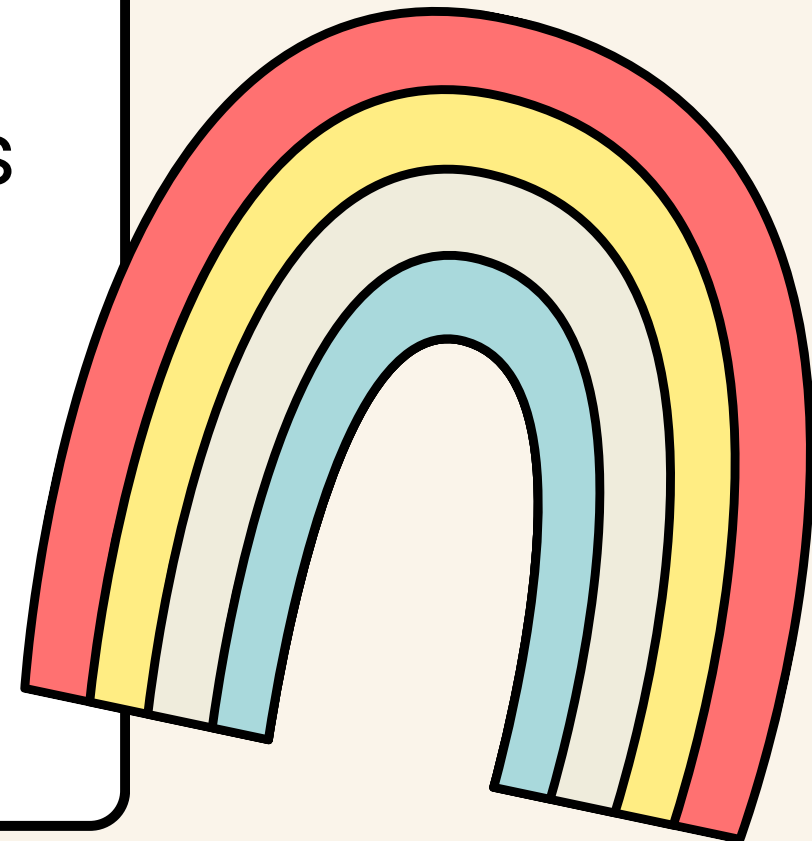
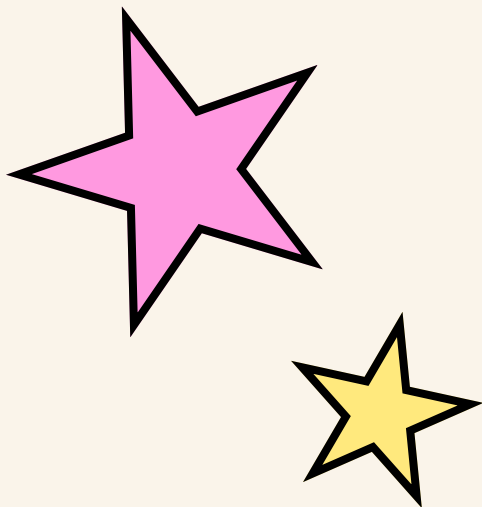


Everyone can succeed!

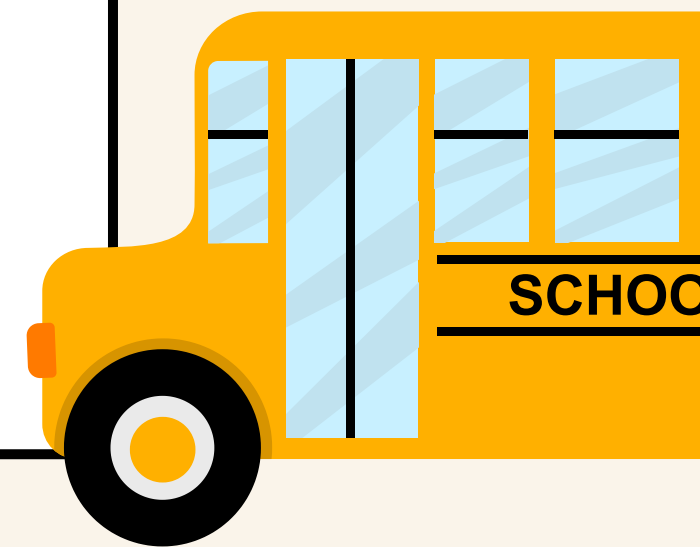
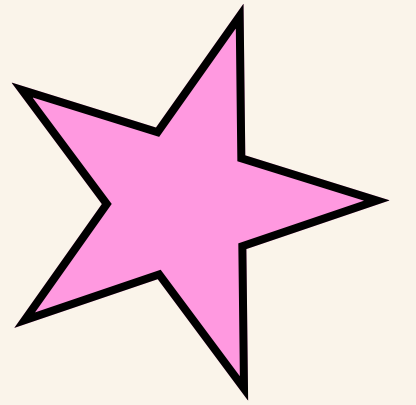
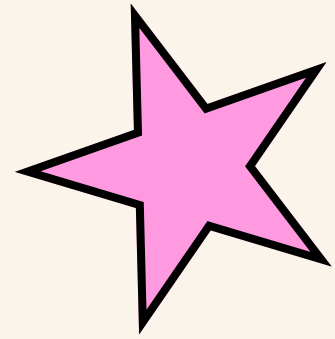
Moving on up!
