

Set A – Spider Instructions

1. Get your piece of paper ready.
2. Draw a spider's body somewhere on the page.
3. Add a head.
4. Draw some eyes on the head.
5. Give your spider some legs.
6. Add a mouth.
7. Decorate your spider to make it look interesting.
8. Give your spider a name.
9. Add anything else you think it needs.
10. Colour it in if you have time.

Set B – Spider Instructions

1. Place your paper in **portrait** position and write your name neatly in the top-right corner.
2. Draw one large oval in the centre of the page for the spider's body.
3. Add one smaller circle overlapping the top of the oval to create the spider's head.
4. Draw two large circular eyes in the middle of the head. Add one small black pupil inside each eye.
5. Carefully draw four long, curved legs emerging from the left side of the body.
6. Draw another four matching curved legs emerging from the right side of the body, making eight legs altogether.
7. Add two small, pointed fangs underneath the spider's eyes.
8. Decorate the body with exactly six small spots or a repeating stripe pattern.
9. Choose a creative name for your spider and write it clearly underneath the drawing.
10. Finally, colour your spider using no more than three colours.
